Common eRA Commons Roles:

Principal Investigator (PD/PI): Required if serving as PD/PI on an NIH proposal (including individual fellowships) Assistant (ASST): Role allows PI to delegate access to ASST to help with award management, RPPR, etc. Sponsor: Required if serving as a Sponsor on an individual NRSA fellowship application. The Sponsor role is also required to perform post-award functions in xTrain

Trainee: (Institutional training grant appointees only) Provides xTrain access for electronic appointment management Post-doctoral: Required for post-docs working on an NIH Research Project (non-NRSA) for at least one person month (for RPPR reporting only) Graduate Student: Required for Graduate Students working on an NIH Research Project (non-NRSA) for at least one person month (for RPPR reporting only)
